Mornington Peninsula Shire nbn™ overview

Summary of nbn™ deployment for Mornington Peninsula Shire

The nbn™ network is now live in parts of Mount Eliza. Further parts of Mount Eliza and Mornington are currently under construction.

Further nbn™ network construction is forecast to commence in the first half of 2016 as per the recent three year plan announcement. The following table outlines nbn™ coverage for Mornington Peninsula Shire:
